

Getting to Know My Country

Category: Practical Life Activity

ORGANIZATION OF THE EXERCISE

Duration: 30 minutes

Arrangement: Children standing in a semi-circle in front of the teacher

Age: 3 to 6 years old

Materials: None specified (optional: visual aids such as a flag, picture of the king and prime minister) **Objective(s):** To introduce children to basic information about Cambodia, including the name of the

country, King, and Prime Minister.

CONDUCT OF THE EXERCISE

Motivation for the Exercise:

The teacher introduces the session by reciting the rhyme "My Country."

Exercise:

The educator uses the rhyme as a tool to help children learn and remember key facts about Cambodia. Through repetition and interaction, the children become familiar with the name of their country, as well as the names of its current king and prime minister. The teacher may engage the children by asking them to repeat the rhyme and answer related questions.

Assessment of Learning:

To reinforce learning, the teacher asks the children review questions to summarize the concepts introduced, such as:

- "What is the name of our country?"
- "Who is the King of Cambodia?"
- "Who is the Prime Minister?"
